Prime Area: Personal, Social and Emotional Development (PSED)

Introduce Pre-School routines including continuous provision/self-chosenactivities, self-registration, self-service snack, tidying up - showing understanding of own and other peoples' needs

Learning names of staff and peers

Entrust Unit 1 - Me and My School, Unit 2 Me and My Relationships

Introduce circle time and calendar activities, carpet time discussions

Look at personal history "How have you changed?"

Empathise with 'Titch'/Owl Babies when reading stories and share own family experiences during circle time

Try out new activities and select resources independently

Specific Area: Expressive Arts and Design (EAD)

Drawing/painting/collage of themselves - observe features/colours in mirror

Sing songs, rhymes and action songs - All By Myself CD, make up own songs

Explore a range of percussion instruments

Role play linked to Health Centre roles/Goldilocks and the 3 Bears, taking on roles in the home corner, Superheroes, dressing up, creating own props

Creative construction using range of construction materials/boxes/materials

Explore different textures/materials

Prime Area: Communication and Language (CL)

Role play - Home Corner (inside) Health Centre/Goldilocks' Cottage (outdoors)

Respond to simple instructions, listen and respond to others using words and gestures, ask questions, extend vocabulary

Listen attentively to stories including Going to School, Titch, I'm Special I'm Me, Peace at Last, From Head to Toe, Owl Babies, Goodnight Moon, Goodnight World, Super Daisy, Super Duck, Super Worm, Super Tato, Eliot Jones Midnight Superhero, Traditional Tales

Songs and rhymes - Nursery Rhymes, If You're Happy, Head, Shoulders, If you are wearing red, Put your finger on your nose

Join in with repeated refrains and actions in stories, rhymes and traditional tales including Goldilocks and the 3 Bears, Little Red Hen

Pre-School Autumn Term 2023

Theme - Super Me



Specific Area: Understanding the World (UW)

Explore classroom and outdoor space

Talk about themselves - likes/dislikes, family and home, creative role play

Look at past and present in relation to themselves - how they have grown/changed from when they were younger

Enjoy small world play, find out about different jobs

Operating simple equipment - microwave, kettle and telephone in role play, computer, mouse, keyboard, ipads

Plant bulbs, tidy the garden using rakes, brooms

Cooking activities including Christmas cakes, soup

Prime Area: Physical Development (PD)

Range of indoor and outdoor play moving in different ways, Sticky Kids, ring/circle games, Super Fitness Friday activities

Funky Fingers fine motor activities, hand/eye co-ordination threading, cutting, puzzles, small construction

Mark making in role play/writing corner, painting, aqua draw, making/copying letters/patterns/marks in sensory materials

Promoting and encourage independence with toileting, hand washing, coats, wellies, shoes, aprons etc.

Super Me Training and challenges

Specific Area: Literacy (L)

Begin to recognise own name on name cards, self-registration board, copy/write own name

Enjoying books, rhymes and stories in book corner, story time, lending library

Games and activities based on L&S Phase 1 Phonics eg sound games, listening walk, instruments, Nursery Rhymes

Draw and paint sometimes giving meaning to marks

Specific Area: Mathematics (M)

See White Rose/Mastering the Curriculum plans: Recognising, naming and matching colours, sorting by various attributes eg size, colour, matching, sorting, size, pattern - continue AB patterns

Size - using the language of size - hand/footprints, 3 Bears, comparing ordering

Counting Principles, using numbers practically in play, counting objects/actions, spotting numbers in play. Exploring Numicon – colours, sizes and patterns of shapes, developing connections with numbers using numicon

Comparing amount of objects, counting and naming body parts

Cooking -comparing quantities, measuring
